Getting involved with the Inishowen Rivers Trust couldn't be easier! We welcome members of the public to engage with the trust and learn more about how a rivers trust can benefit our communities.

The IRT aims to conserve, protect, rehabilitate and improve the rivers, and natural waters of the Inishowen Municipal District. It also aims to increase awareness and understanding of these water bodies, helping us to protect the river's natural fauna and flora, while connecting communities that are working to improve our water quality.

How do I become a member of the Trust?

Membership of the IRT is open to community groups and individuals who live within the Inishowen Municipal District or have an interest in the area. It's easy to register and there is no fee. Simply complete this form and post it to us or download the form from our website, fill it out and email it back to us.

What happens when I register?

When you register with the IRT we will keep your details on record and keep you up to date with our work. We will also send you our quarterly newsletter, keeping you informed of volunteer and training opportunities and letting you know about our public meetings. These meetings take place in various locations around the peninsula and are an opportunity for you to meet others and make suggestions to the Trust.
