## **About Inishowen Rivers Trust**

The Trust is a registered environmental charity (charity number 20153106) and Company Limited by Guarantee (Company number 587285). The Trust was founded in 2016 with the aim of working with local communities to conserve, protect, rehabilitate and improve the rivers and natural waterbodies of the Inishowen Municipal District, including adjacent estuarine and coastal areas, for the advancement of environmental protection or improvement for the benefit of the public.

The Trust has pioneered a community focussed approach to water management within Inishowen, including a practical based learning programme that delivers action based projects and develops a strong skillset within the community.

We are seeking an experienced film maker to produce short, high quality training clips filmed in an outdoor setting. Experience of developing training videos desirable.

The successful contractor is required to:

- Record high quality footage of IRT training to illustrate specific skills. Training will be held primarily outdoors but may also include some indoor sessions. Close up footage will be required and some drone footage is desirable.
- Ensure high quality audio for the footage.
- Film four training modules. Modules take place over 1-2 days but the contractor will not be required to be on site for the entire period. Schedules will be agreed in advance.
- Be available over weekends when training takes place.
- Edit all footage and liaise with IRT Training Co-ordinator and Project Officer to complete the films in a timely manner.
- Provide footage suitable for YouTube, FB and larger format presentation.
- Provide a copy of their insurance which should be in place for the duration of the project.
- Provide a tax clearance access number from Revenue Commissioners.
- Comply with required Health & Safety standards in the delivery of the work.
- Comply with required Data Protection standards in the delivery of the work.

- Project end date: 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021
