### **Comments on Harvest Board**

- Empower Non-consumer culture Nuture the people (quiet ones & enthusiastic ones) -Take responsibility and giving care
- Promotion of forestry / woodlands as catchment protection
- Flooding Communication system, warning awareness. Appropriate planning or resilient construction
- Crana Fest canoeing need to get them involved
- Shared office space Crana angling association and IRT in Buncrana.
- Need baseline salmon assessment of Crana. Need to upskill BAA and IRT in electrofishing and habitat assessment to compliment IFI monitoring
- Poor management of biodiversity resource. Bredagh better now but needs more sites and diversity of sites
- Work with UU / LYIT / Greencastle Fisheries school to provide opportunities to fishery/habitats assessment.
- Access to riparian edge. Not connected, Poor markings, Pathways or trails or discovery ways.
- Potential for renewal of biodiversity sites
- Difficult to get grants for in-stream projects, IRT need to look at whole catchment projects on in-stream projects
- Get young involved build capacity of natural heritage organisations to work with young people e.g. volunteering
- Hang out in woods Sit spot
- Remember the Trees Awareness and shared work on invasives. NB catchment approach and not spot / isolated
- Birds are our teachers

- We need to care together and consult the experienced community

- Action speaks louder than words lift rubbish more care
- We need to stop raw sewage at Westbrook Station in River Crana DCC / Irish Water

- Litter deliberate and persistent Education (no connection to local streams)
- Treatment plant upgrades needed IW / DCC need to clarify who is responsible for what plant / pump. Is it a combined SO?
